Introduction

This is the second of two exhibitions to inform the public of progress with this important Scheme to protect Selkirk from the threat of flooding.

The purpose of this exhibition is to show you the measures which are being proposed to reduce the risk of flooding in Selkirk and Lindean from the Etrick Water, the Long Philip Burn and the Shaw Burn. These measures have been developed in partnership with those directly affected by the Scheme.
