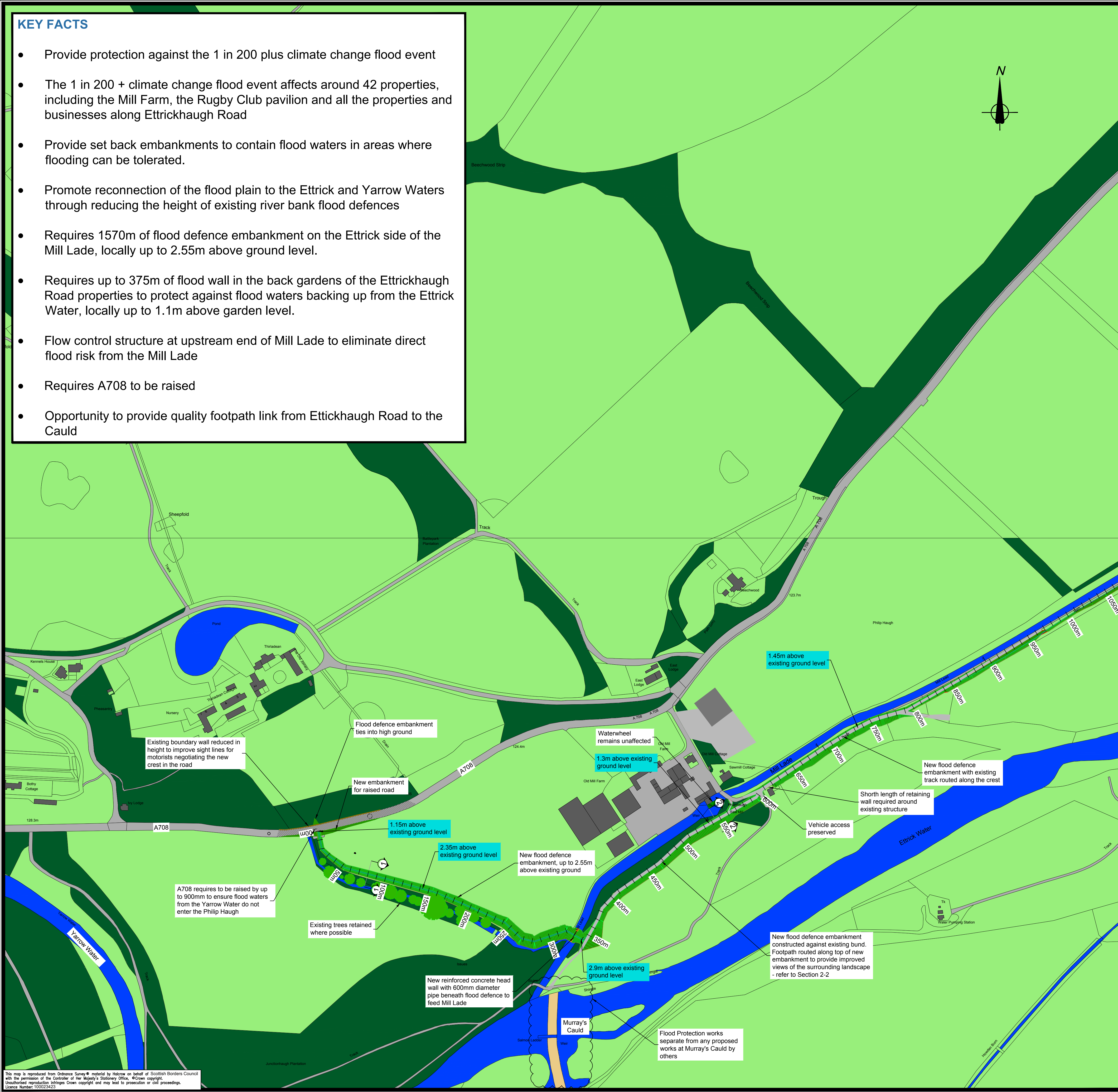
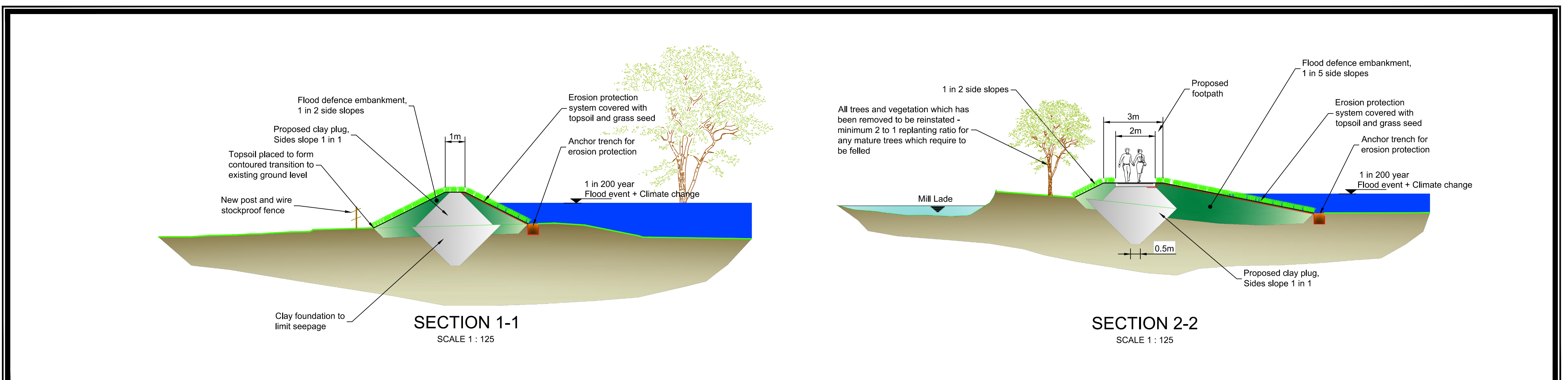


### KEY FACTS

- Provide protection against the 1 in 200 plus climate change flood event
- The 1 in 200 + climate change flood event affects around 42 properties, including the Mill Farm, the Rugby Club pavilion and all the properties and businesses along Ettrickhaugh Road
- Provide set back embankments to contain flood waters in areas where flooding can be tolerated.
- Promote reconnection of the flood plain to the Ettrick and Yarrow Waters through reducing the height of existing river bank flood defences
- Requires 1570m of flood defence embankment on the Ettrick side of the Mill Lade, locally up to 2.55m above ground level.
- Requires up to 375m of flood wall in the back gardens of the Ettrickhaugh Road properties to protect against flood waters backing up from the Ettrick Water, locally up to 1.1m above garden level.
- Flow control structure at upstream end of Mill Lade to eliminate direct flood risk from the Mill Lade
- Requires A708 to be raised
- Opportunity to provide quality footpath link from Ettrickhaugh Road to the Cauld
