

**Selkirk Flood Protection Scheme**20<sup>th</sup> February 2015**Work Section 14, 15 & 16 (WS-01 to 16) – Works Update**

Dear Sir / Madam,

The Main Works for the Selkirk Flood Protection Scheme work sections 14 through to 16(WS-14 to 16) will commence on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> of February 2015.

One of the first operations to be carried out will involve the setting up of the site boundary fence line to allow general site clearance and the excavation of trial holes in order to establish the location of all existing utility services. These works require the closure of Riverside Road and footpath. The works involving the road closure are programmed to take over a period of 25 weeks, until early August 2015. We will make every effort to minimise this duration and complete this section of work early.

The Main Works Site Compound and Offices are currently being installed at South Bridge Street on the site of the former Bridgehaugh Dyeworks. There will be a Public Information Centre within the offices which will be available shortly for any information, enquiries, etc.
